Remove unwanted hairs of the area to be treated with a hand shaver or razor.

Press and hold the POWER/LEVEL button.

Press the POWER/LEVEL button.

# Flashing light

Press the FLASH button.

# Turn off the device

Press and hold the POWER/LEVEL button.



Do not use the device if those parts are damaged or malfunctioning.

- Do not use, store or charge the device in the following locations:
  - Bathroom, shower room, or near the wash basin or other containers (it is okay to use the device)
  - A dusty location, a location where there is exposure to direct sunlight or outdoors
  - Uneven or unstable location, or a location where there is vibration or shocks
  - A location where there are strong radio waves or magnetism
  - Near a flammable substance (such as alcohol, thinner, benzene, nail polish remover or spray).

- There is no problem with the areas treated with flashes overlapping with each other to some extent in each use of the device.
- Do not use perfume, cosmetics, or antiperspirant on the treated areas immediately after treatment is completed (excluding any cream or lotion for moisture retention).

Failure to comply may cause skin problems.

# CAUTION (Use and storage)

During the treatment, carefully check that your skin is not showing any abnormalities.

Stop using the device immediately if you start to feel pain, fatigue or see any skin reaction during use.

Stop using the device immediately if the treatment does not agree with your skin.

If symptoms persist the following day and beyond, consult a physician.

• Refrain from hard exercise and drinking alcohol on the day of treatment.

Failure to comply may cause skin problems.

For twenty-four hours after the flash treatment, avoid exposing the treated area to ultraviolet rays.



If redness continues to be exhibited even after 24 hours, avoid UV light.

Also, protect your skin with sunscreen, etc. while undergoing treatment. Failure to comply may cause skin problems.

Must Comply

• Be sure to wipe off moisture from the main unit after use.

Also, do not leave the device in hot or humid places, such as in a bathroom.

Leaving the main unit wet could cause damage.

• Remove any bits of hair remaining on your skin before use.



## **Functions**

## Safety function

Touch sensor

You can flash your skin once the device detects that the treatment window is fully touching on your skin.

## Auto Power Off

About ten minutes after the device has been powered on, it will be automatically shut off after two beeps. To resume using the device, wait at least ten minutes before proceeding.

## Cooling feature

After the power is turned off, the fan in the device keeps operating for approx. three minutes. It is a function to cool the device.

## Waterproof

This product (excluding the AC adapter) is IPX7 level waterproof\* (IIS waterproof protection class).

- \* The product is not designed to use underwater, so please be careful when using the device in bathrooms or around water.
- Never charge the device when it is wet.
- The AC adapter is not waterproof.

## Charging Guide Display

The device tells you that the battery level is low when the power is turned off. When "L" is shown on the LEVEL indicator and the device beeps six times, it means the battery level is low. Charge the battery before the next use.



When treating the V-, I-, and O-lines, use the attachments suitable for each area

## Before Use

Before carrying out a treatment, be sure to check the following contents.

## Preparing for treatment

Be sure to remove excess hair at the area to be treated with a handheld shaver or razor.

A burn injury may result if excess hair is allowed to grow long or remain on the surface of the skin at the area to be treated.

- \* Avoid tweezing or removing hair with wax or other such means.
- Check to make sure there is nothing unusual about the head, treatment window, or attachment. Do not use if damaged or deformed.
  - Be sure to clean the device if it gets dirty. Failure to comply may damage and deteriorate the device or cause burns, injuries, or skin problems.
  - · See 'How To Clean' (page 28) for usage instructions.
- Be sure to perform a Flash test before using the device for the first time.

Apply a flash to an area near the intended care area starting with <u>Level 1</u> in a single flashing. Use BODY Mode for the body, FACE Mode for the face, and VIO Mode for the V-, I-, and O-lines (refer to pages 20-27).

- You can use the device if no abnormality appears on your skin 24 hours after performing the flash test.
- Adolescents must use the device with close attention to safety under the supervision of their parent and, when there is abnormality, stop using the
  device immediately.

Due to factors related to hormonal balance, damage may be caused to the skin, or the treatment may not yield observable results while the user has not reached full adulthood.



- For hygienic reasons, do not share the VI and O attachments with your family members or friends.
- Lighting during use
  - Using the device in a very dark environment may cause injury to your eyes.
  - If you want to check the color chart, please use it in bright light.

    (For details on the color chart, please read the included "Safety Precautions".)
  - · Avoid use in the following conditions.
  - An indirectly lit room
  - A very dark room, such as one lit only by miniature bulbs
  - Dark places such as under a table

## Treatment cycle



Effects will appear differently depending on the area where the device is used and the individual.

\* The device is not intended to be used to achieve permanent hair removal.

Do not apply flashes on the same area more than once a day


(As for soft flashing, three high-speed pulses are counted as one flash).

Do not engage in excessive use of the device.

## CAUTION

If you wish to use the device in excess of the aforementioned frequency, be sure to use it while checking the condition of the skin. In addition, always adhere to the prescribed frequency of use per day. Failure to comply may cause skin problems.

## Charge the Device



- Charging starts when the AC adapter is connected to the device.
- When the device is being charged, the segments of LEVEL indicator are lit one by one in order. When the device is fully charged, LEVEL indicator displays "F" for 30 seconds and then turnss off.
- At an indoor temperature of approx. 25° C, it will take about two and a half hours to reach a full charge, at which the device can operate for about 20 minutes. Actual charging time and operating time may vary depending upon the remaining battery level and the charging environment.
- \* If charging does not begin after approx. 10 seconds, check if the AC adapter connection is loose.
  - If there is any moisture on or around the main unit or charging terminal, be sure to wipe it dry. Charging while
    moisture remained could cause an electric shock, short circuit, fire, or a malfunction of the device.
  - The device cannot be used when it is being charged. Remove the AC adapter before use. If you try to charge the device
    while the power is on, the power turns off.

## **CAUTION**

- Never charge the device in the bathroom.
- Fully charge the battery before using the device for the first time.
- When using the device for the first time or when the device has not been used for an extended period of time, it is possible
  that you will be unable to use the device for very long even with a full charge status is displayed. In such cases, recharge the
  device before using it.
- When the cord is broken, replace the AC adapter with a new one.

## Basic Method of Use




## Turn on the device

Press and hold the POWER/LEVEL button (approx. 3 seconds). The power turns on after two short beeps.

When MODE indicator and LEVEL indicator are lit and the device emits two short beep sounds, the device is in Standby Mode.

When the device is turned on, the device is set at level 1 of single flashing.



**CAUTION** 

• Remove the AC adapter before use. The device cannot be used while it is charging.

## How to set the mode

• Fit an attachment while the device is turned on, the appropriate mode will be selected automatically after one short beep, and the device will start single flashing (page 24) in level 1 (page 22).

#### How to connect an attachment

The attachment can only connect to the device in the right direction.



\*The facial attachment is used as an example in the description.

Fit the attachment to the device so that it covers the treatment window, with the attachment's name facing up. Since it is magnetic, it will stay in place if it is covering the treatment window.

- \* Make sure nothing is in between the treatment window and the
- st When the attachment is upside down, it cannot be fit to the device.

#### How to remove an attachment




Hold the attachment on both sides and pull it toward you.

• If you fit or remove the attachment while the power is on, the mode changes (page 21) after a short beep and the device is automatically set at level 1 (see below) of single flashing (page 24).

## Select a level/irradiation type

Every time you press the POWER/LEVEL button, one beep sounds and the level/irradiation type changes.



The levels/irradiation type changes as follows.

Every time the irradiation type changes, the device emits a long beep sound followed by a short beep sound.

· Single flashing/continuous flashing (BODY Mode, FACE Mode)


CAUTION

Use only level 1 upon first use and until you are accustomed to use.



## How to apply treatment

#### Common to all modes



\* The illustration uses BODY Mode as an example.

Put the treatment window on the skin after two short beeps.

When the white light of the FLASH button turns on, press the FLASH button and apply flashes to the skin.

See 'Tips For Your Treatment' (page 25) for tips on performing treatments for different areas.

- \*The product is not designed to use underwater, so please be careful when using the device in bathrooms or around water.
- \* Wear sunglasses if you feel that the light is too bright during your treatment. Failure to comply may cause damage to your eyes or skin.
- It may take longer to prepare for treatment depending on the level.
- This product is designed to prevent the treatment head from producing excess heat by adjusting the flashing interval, so that the head does not cause damage to users by heating up when continuous flashing is performed continuously.

The flashing interval varies depending on how hot the head is and the environment in which the device is used.

 Remove the head from the skin after applying a flash to one area and move the head little by little to apply flashes to different areas.

# **CAUTION**

- Since the skin around the face contour is susceptible to getting caught in the treatment window, be careful not to press too strongly while flashing.
- Always wait at least 10 minutes after turning off the power before using the device again.
   Continual use may cause a malfunction of the device.
- Be careful not to let the filter (transparent glass) touch the skin.

## • Single flashing (once) <can be used in all the modes> MODE indicator is lit

Press the FLASH button to irradiate a single flashing while shifting the position of the device.

• There are a few seconds of charging time after every single flash (the time varies depending on the level).

## Continuous flashing <BODY Mode, FACE Mode> MODE indicator flashes

When you press the LEVEL button when the device is set at level 5 of single flashing, the level changes to level 1 of continuous flashing.

MODE indicator changes to flashing. Choose among levels 1 to 5


(When you press the LEVEL button when the device is set at level 5 of continuous flashing, the level changes to level 1 of single flashing).

- Flashes are emitted while the FLASH button is pressed.
- If you put the treatment window on the skin and press the FLASH button again after continuous flashing is finished, you can perform continuous flashing again

(Up to 10 continuous flashes can be emitted in BODY Mode and up to 5 continuous flashes can be emitted in FACE Mode).

• When the treatment window is removed from the skin for 15 seconds, the device beeps and is reset to the state before the first pulse was emitted.


## Soft flashing <VIO Mode only> MODE indicator flashes

When you press the LEVEL button when the device is set at level 5 of single flashing, the level changes to level 1 of soft flashing.

MODE indicator changes to flashing. Choose among levels 1 to  $5\,$ 

(When you press the LEVEL button when the device is set at level 5 of soft flashing, the level changes to level 1 of single flashing).

- Press the Flash button to flash light while moving the device over your skin.
- $\bullet \, \mathsf{Three} \, \mathsf{high}\mathsf{-speed} \, \mathsf{soft} \, \mathsf{continuous} \, \mathsf{flashes} \, \mathsf{are} \, \mathsf{applied} \, \mathsf{to} \, \mathsf{the} \, \mathsf{same} \, \mathsf{area}.$
- It is recommended for those who do not like the instant stimulation caused by single flashing and those who are sensitive to heat.




## **Tips For Your Treatment**

Keep the following points in mind when performing treatment.

## Arms/legs

Hold the treatment window perpendicular to the skin.



## Underarms

Perform treatment while stretching out the skin with your fingers.

• Before performing treatment, carefully wipe away any antiperspirant or other cosmetic products on the skin.

## Bikini line

Use the device at a low level on areas where there is pigmentation or areas with darker skin tone.

\* Be sure to start from level 1 and adjust as you become more accustomed to the device.

## Face

Refrain from applying flash treatments without first removing foundation and other makeup products that have been applied to the skin.

Failure to comply may cause a burn injury or skin problems.


- Use the device with a degree of intensity sufficient for you to perceive a slight warmth.
- When using the device on a narrow area such as mustache or beard, or a area with a sharp angle, perform the treatment while stretching out the skin with your fingers.
- Refrain from suntanning while undergoing treatment and avoid direct sunlight after treatment.
- When applying flashes, press the treatment window firmly against the skin and be careful not to expose your eyes to the flashes.

## VIO area

#### V-line

Perform treatment while stretching out the skin with your fingers.

When you style your pubic hair using the attached V designing tool, shave the area inside the V-line completely and apply flashes.

You can choose among the four designs and style your pubic hair inside the V-line based on it.

Each design is adjustable to three sizes.

#### <How to Use>

- Choose the shape and decide on the size.
- 2 Cut the tool to the right size for you along the dotted line with scissors.
  - \* Adjust the size from large to small
- 3 Shave the area inside the V-line.
  - \* Even if you want to keep your hair, make sure to shave the area completely.

- 4 Push the tab to one side.
- 5 Press the tool against the V-line area with the hand that is not used to hold the device.
- 6 Use the device to apply flashes to the areas around the tool.
  - \* From the second treatment onward, perform the treatment by pressing the same tool you used for the first treatment to the same area.

#### I- and O-lines

<Recommended usage>

Put a mirror on the floor and get down on one knee over the mirror as shown in the figure.

Check the area to apply flashes to in the mirror.

- \* Check whether the area to treat is completely shaved.
- \* After checking the area in the mirror, apply flashes without directly looking into the mirror.
- \* Do not apply flashes directly to the mucosa.
- \* Do not flash the light inside the I-line, such as on male genitalia.

# Turn off the device

- Press and hold the POWER/LEVEL button for approx. 3 seconds.
- Please confirm that the fan in the device has stopped (approx. three minutes).
- After each use, refer to 'After Treatment' (page 28) and remove the remaining sebum, serum and other particles that have adhered to the device

If your skin remains hot feeling after use, cool your skin down sufficiently by applying a cold towel.

Your skin may feel hot after carrying out a treatment depending on your physical constitution and method of use. If you are concerned about the hot flashes on your skin, cool it down by applying a ice pack or cold towel to the area. Consult a physician if the abnormality does not subside.

• Be sure to use the mode that is appropriate to the area being treated. Failure to comply may cause a burn injury.

## CAUTION

- Ensure that neither you nor anyone else looks directly into the treatment window of the device. Also ensure that no one nearby looks at the treatment window. Failure to comply may cause injury to your eyes.
- Moisturize your skin daily to prevent your skin from becoming dry. If your skin is dry, the device might not work properly.

When treating the face, press the treatment window firmly against the skin. If the treatment window is not pressed firmly against the skin, the flashing light may become overly bright.

## How To Clean


Please carefully clean the parts of the device that come into contact with the skin every time you use it and keep the device clean at all times.

Failure to comply may cause skin problems.

Regularly clean the device also to prevent it from failing or malfunctioning.


Be sure to turn the power off and wipe off moisture after use.

## Flash irradiation window



\* Wipe away fingerprints and other stains. Failure to comply may cause the filter to become scorched, a diminishment of flash performance, a malfunction of the device, or skin problems.

#### Main unit



- For stubborn stains, wipe with a sponge or cloth soaked in a diluted neutral detergent.
- \* If there is any moisture on or around the charging terminal, be sure to wipe it dry.

#### Attachment

- Remove an attachment from the device and wash it under running water.
- 2 Wipe off moisture with a soft cloth.

#### V design tool

- 1 Wash the tool under running water.
- 2 Wipe off moisture with a soft cloth or tissue.

Do not wipe the device with solvents such as alcohol, thinner, benzene, nail polish remover, kerosene, chemicals, or polishing powder.

Failure to comply may cause damage to the surface of the device.



## Storing the Device

- Always remove excess water and dry thoroughly before storing. Leaving the device wet may cause a malfunction or corrosion.
- If not using the device for a long period of time, clean the device before storing it.
- Turn the device off when not in use.
- Avoid using or storing the device near a heater, in a high-temperature/high-humidity location, locations where there is exposure to direct sunlight, or unstable locations.
- Keep the device out of the reach of children.
- Do not keep the device in wet locations such as the bathroom.

## Maintenance and Inspections

- 🎈 If you have not used the device for an extended period, inspect it carefully and check that it works properly and safely before using it again.
- If the device is malfunctioning, go to 'Troubleshooting' (page 30) and attempt to identify the problem before arranging to have the device repaired. If the problem persists, contact your local distributor, making sure that you have your purchase details ready when you call.

Error display

When an error occurs, error information is displayed on LEVEL indicator of the device.

Check the error in question as outlined below and eliminate the cause of the error accordingly.

## Frequently Asked Questions

The flash pulses feel hot and redness or pain is recognized. Is this normal?

- Start using the device from level 1.
- Once you become comfortable with this level, gradually raise the level.
   Perceiving a slight measure of heat from flash pulses is normal and does not cause any skin problem.
- This problem can be attributed to the presence of long bits of excess hair or to the treatment of suntanned skin with flash pulses.
- Use the device after getting rid of excess hair with a handheld shaver or razor and on skin that has not been suntanned.
- If redness or pain is manifested, discontinue using the device immediately and cool down and moisturize the skin. If there is no amelioration, discontinue using the device and see a physician.
  - \* Be sure to use the facial attachment when treating the face and the VI attachment or O attachment when treating the private parts. Failure to comply may cause a burn injury.
- Be careful not to let the filter (transparent glass) touch the skin.
   When the device is being used, the filter becomes extremely hot and may cause skin burns.
- Do not press the device too firmly against the areas where the skin is soft or there is a
  lot of fat under the skin.
  - Be careful when using the device to treat the rounded parts, such as elbows and knees.

How often can I use the device per day?

A Do not flash-illuminate the same area more than once a day.

Intense heat-generated stimulation may give rise to skin problems.

Immediately after a flash pulse
is discharged, I can smell a
burning odor. Is this normal?

The burning odor comes from the heating of excess hair caused by the flash pulse.

A If a burning odor is emitted by the device itself, immediately discontinue use and turn the device off.

Q Can I use the device in the bathroom?

Though the device can be used in the bathroom, it cannot be used underwater.

In addition, do not charge the device in the bathroom.

Can I share the device
with my family members
or friends?

The device can be shared for BODY Mode that does not require any attachment or treatment with the facial attachment. When sharing the device, be sure to clean the device and attachment before use.

Do not share the VI attachment and O attachment with anyone.

Can I use the device on the skin on which the cooling/moisturizing gel is used?

Do not use the device because it may cause malfunction. Use the gel when there is redness or pain after use.
